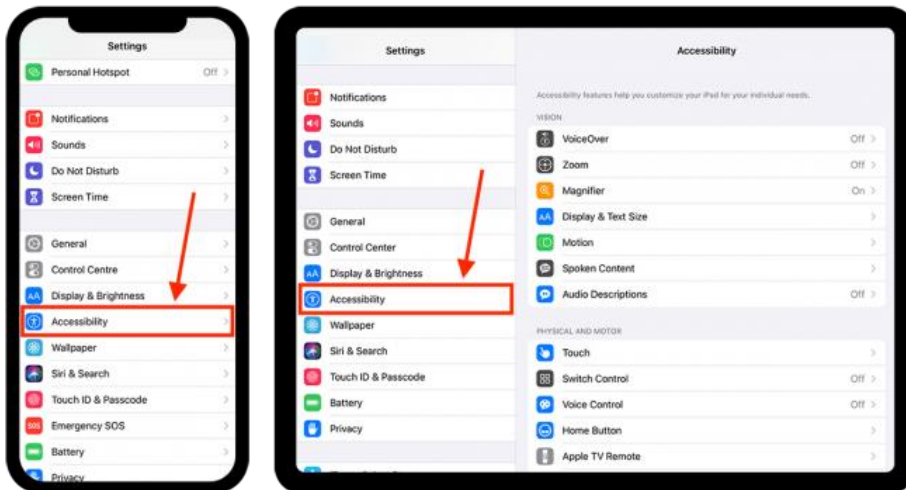


Setting up a Bluetooth headset as default audio on an iPhone

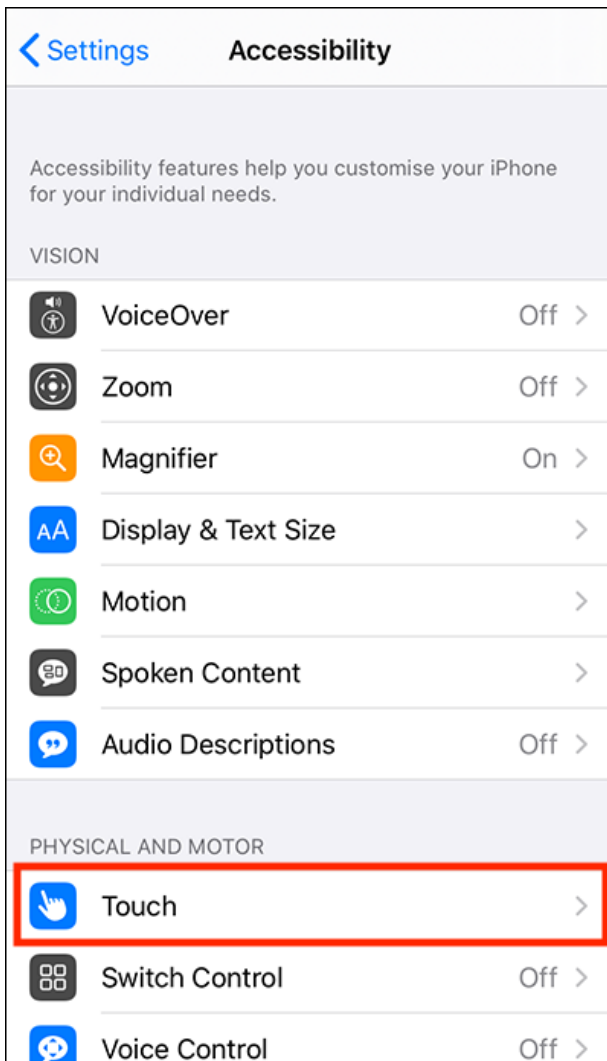
1. Open the **Settings** app on your iOS device.



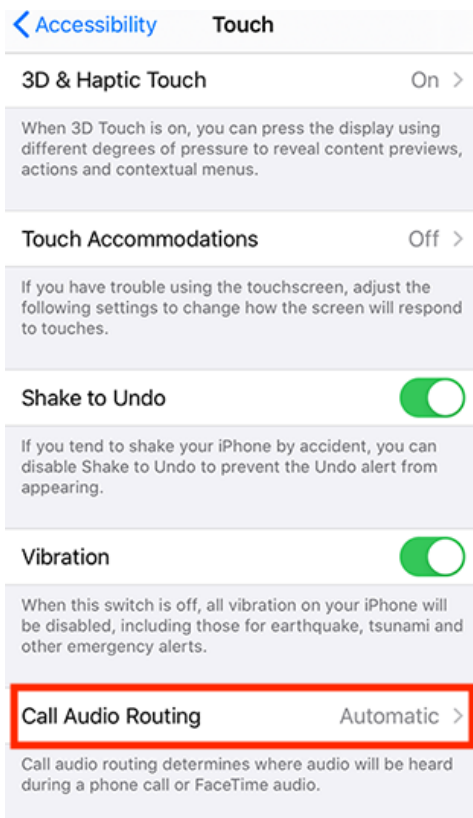
2. In the Settings app, select **Accessibility** from the list.



3. On the Accessibility screen, select **Touch**.



4. On the Touch screen, scroll to the bottom and select **Call Audio Routing**.



- On the Call Audio Routing screen, select **Bluetooth Headset**. This will change the call audio routing to ensure all calls answered will go to the headset when it is connected to your mobile phone.



- Navigate back to the top of iPhone Settings, select **Bluetooth**, select the blue "i" to the right side of the Jabra device in the list, set **Device Type** as **Headphone**.



When you don't want to use the headset, just turn off Bluetooth
